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RESTAT QUANTITY LIMITATIONS PROGRAM WORKS FOR YOU

PROGRAM

RESTAT has partnered with your employer, as their Prescription Benefits Manager (PBM), for your prescription plan. We are working to help manage prescription costs, while you continue to receive appropriate and safe medications. The RESTAT Quantity Limitations Program will positively affect the affordability of your prescription drug plan. You will continue to receive safe and appropriate, yet cost-effective medications through this program.

PROCESS

RESTAT's Clinical Pharmacists recognized that some medications available today are not used on a daily basis, but instead are used as needed. Your employer has asked RESTAT to limit a set day supply at the pharmacy, i.e. 34 days at retail. Since the medications identified with this program are not intended to be taken on a daily basis; the day supply allowed will be smaller than typical medications.



EXAMPLE OF PROGRAM

An individual may take a migraine medication, known as a Triptan. A Triptan is not to be used more than three times a month for typical migraine relief. RESTAT routinely sees pharmacies submit a claim for 30 tablets with a 10 day supply, even though an individual dose does not require three tablets a day. The cost of migraine medication is approximately \$16.20 per tablet. The above example costs \$486.00 per prescription. Your employer has elected to use the Quantity Limitation Program, which will limit the quantity to 6, 9, or 12 tablets per claim, in this example, based on the drug's package size. Please refer to the insert within this pamphlet to determine the quantity of medication that may effect you.

RESULT

You may receive notification from RESTAT's Clinical Department regarding this program and a medication you are taking. Please refer to the insert within this pamphlet to determine the quantity of medication which will be approved by your employer. Quantity Limitations are based upon current medical findings, manufacturer-labeling information, managed care practices and the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) guidelines.
